Funded by a grant of £8.6k from the [National Lottery Community Fund](#), we will offer people aged 50+ and living on their own a mix of general exercise and dedicated tennis coaching. This will be followed by an hour of peaceful contemplation in the neighbouring Birmingham Botanical Gardens to promote mental health and wellbeing. ## PLAY YOUR WAY TO WIMBLEDON

Congratulations to Catherine & Janine who qualified for the national finals of Play Your Way to Wimbledon earlier this month. The tournament is the UK's largest individual mass participation tennis competition, which provides players with the opportunity to compete on the world-famous grass



courts at SW19. The pair came up against some

solid competition in the round robin stage and didn't manage to progress to the knock-outs but had an amazing time soaking up the atmosphere. The competition was held on the Aorangi practice courts adjacent to No.1 Court – fourteen additional grass courts usually hidden from general view during the Championships. A fantastic experience and an opportunity the Archery hopes to provide again next year.

## ITF CHAMPIONS

This month saw a profusion of Archery representation at Wimbledon. There was better luck for Head Coach Tom Barton and his partner Bojan Jelovic, who won the Men's Doubles at the ITF Masters MT700 - London (British Closed). Tom is now back in the top 3 in the ITF World Ranking for Men's 35+ Doubles.
