All of this contributed to the club staying open during the periods we were allowed to. We had no additional shutdowns at the club.

• MAST

We wrote to the membership on 24-April-21 to inform that we had been approached by a company called Waldon Telecom Ltd on behalf of Cornerstone Telecommunications Infrastructure Limited (a joint venture company between the telecoms operators O2 and Vodafone) with regards to a proposed mobile base station at Elmwood Tennis Club.

In November we sent further update with latest communications. Nothing formal has happened yet. We confirmed that our position remains the same, they have no right to access Elmwood's land and that there is unanimous opposition against the mast from the membership community, the trustees, and the elected committee. We suggested it would be in their interest to consider other locations for a mast given that Elmwood has no intentions of allowing Cornerstone to install telecoms on our land and that we would not wish to lead them on and in doing so unduly waste their time. Waldon have informed us that a new planner is yet to be allocated and that they are still waiting for some additional feedback from Brent Council, so will continue to take further comments.

The club funded a Plaque in memory of Henry Oluwarotimi Williams (long term ex-member). His family provided an inscription and it is on the corner of all Souls Avenue by the fence.

Treasurers Report & Bar Stewards Report – Hakeem Khalil


The Revenue Account and Balance Sheet was distributed and explained at length by Hakeem. At the end of the Financial Year 30-Sept-21 the club's finances are in a very healthy condition. The bar revenue is down as expected during the pandemic however subscriptions have increased.

Men's Captain & Fixtures Secretary's Report

Winter 2021/2022 2 teams will be entered **VETS**- Middlesex Seniors 40/O League Summer 2021 **Division 1 East** Captained by Magda, finished 4th out of 8. Winter 2021/2022 **Division 4 Group E** Membership Secretary's Report – Richard Ormerod & Guy Batchelor Membership stands at 741 members (455 playing adults) and £68,431 membership fees. Total for 2020/21 583 members (339 playing adults) and £57,204 (2019/20 368 members and £38,550). Off-Peak membership has been offered to 1-April-22 to everyone on the Waiting List. 33 Off-Peak Adults and 23 Off-Peak Family have joined or renewed so far, and several have declined. The Waiting List stands at 261 entries (representing 365 adults).
