Flitwick and Ampthill Tennis Club offers not just social tennis, but competitive tennis against other clubs.

The Club enters over twenty teams, of varying ages and abilities, with both mixed and even doubles teams in both the Bedfordshire County and South Bedfordshire Leagues. We also enter the National Inter Club Knock Out tournament, and the National Veterans Tournament.

During the course of the summer the club championships take place with singles, doubles and junior events where players play competitively against their fellow members, ending with a special Finals Day held in September every year.
