

Glossop Tennis Club Rules

Court Etiquette

Please:

- use non-marking footwear.
- do not take chairs, bikes, buggies etc onto the court as they may cause damage.
- make every effort to retrieve balls hit into the field.
- be considerate to other players when playing and watching matches.

Member

New applications for membership must be made via the Club's website or separately via direct arrangement with the Membership Secretary

Confirmation of admission of membership will be provided by the Membership Secretary following an interval of at least two days following the receipt of the application or nomination for membership.

Only senior members are permitted to have a roller door key

Alcohol is only to be served to members or guests over the age of 18.

Alcohol Sales

The purchase of alcohol for the Club, and the supply of alcohol by the Club, are managed by the Club's Bar committee whose members—

- (a) are members of the Club;
- (b) have attained the age of 18 years; and
- (c) are elected by the members of the Club

No arrangements are, or are intended to be, made for any person to receive at the expense of the Club any commission, percentage or similar payment on, or with reference to, purchases of alcohol by the Club.

No arrangements are, or are intended to be, made for any person directly or indirectly to derive any pecuniary benefit from the supply of alcohol by or on behalf of the Club to members or guests, apart from

- (a) any benefit accruing to the Club as a whole, or
- (b) any benefit which a person derives indirectly by reason of the supply giving rise or contributing to a general gain from the carrying on of the Club.

Only alcohol purchased on the club premises is to be consumed on the club premises.

Court Availability

Social tennis is open to all senior members and nominated junior members. Social tennis dates and time may vary throughout the year and will be advised by the committee.

Group coaching currently takes place on Wednesday and Thursday evenings from 4pm-9pm. Group Coaching times are subject to change. Private coaching session times as agreed with

individual members are to be booked via the court booking system.

Court bookings for all play, including individually arranged sessions, team matches and social tennis are to be made via the club's website. Team matches and social tennis are booked into the system by the committee.

Court bookings will take priority over non-booked courts

League tennis matches take place on most Sundays between April and July. Precise dates will be shown on the Club's website.

Floodlights

Tokens for the floodlights can be purchased on social evenings or by arrangement with a Committee Member for £2 per token. Each token allows for 30mins of play. Floodlights must not be on after 10pm.

First Aid

A first aid kit is available in the upper left kitchen cupboard. Any serious injuries are to be entered in the log book available and notified to the Committee as soon as possible.

Guests

Senior members may bring guests. Each guest must sign in and pay £5 to a committee member or direct into the Club's Bank Account as soon as reasonably possible. An individual can play as a guest a maximum of 3 separate visits in a calendar year unless otherwise agreed with the Committee.

Junior members are permitted to play with a parent or guardian who is not a Member and no guest fee will be payable.

Locking up

If you are the last senior member to leave the clubhouse please make sure the lights are off and lock up securely, including windows, roller shutter and boundary gate.

If there is an issue with the security of the clubhouse please notify a Committee Member as soon as possible.
