

***How will you design the event timetable to ensure social distancing is maintained at all times?***

- 09:00 – 09:30 Relays / Warm Up

***What will you put in place to minimise encounters between people?***

Venue to be set up for social distancing at breaks, only one child at any time to be allowed in the toilet area and must ask permission from the coach.

***How will you brief participants in advance of the event?***

All players and parents will be given guidance notes prior to the event. All players will be reminded at the beginning of the day by the coaches. All players will also be recommended to read the guidance notes on the LTA website <https://www.lta.org.uk/globalassets/venue/support-your-venue/documents/lta-guidance-for-tennis-players---covid-19.pdf> to ensure they protect themselves wherever possible.

***How will you ensure that participants and parents/guardians can remain socially distanced at all times?***

All parents attending the site will register their child and will be asked to leave the premises once this is done, no waiting indoors. There will be one coach to register, one to greet and ensure only one parent at a time inside the building with the child/children and one upstairs looking after the children.

Lunch and break each child will be given their own space marked for where they should remain throughout. Players to be regularly reminded throughout each activity to be socially distant wherever possible and should use sanitiser wherever possible.

***How will you limit shared use of equipment (i.e. rackets)?***

Each child will be given a racket at the start of the day which they can use. We also encourage children to bring their own if at all possible.

***What precautions will you put in place to ensure good hand hygiene from participants?***

Sanitiser will be available for all coaches and participants. All coaches and participants will be asked to sanitise their hands before and after any break.

***How will you manage any rain delays?***

This is not applicable due to indoor facilities however for activities that can be played outdoors if the weather is nice coaches will be able to do so.

***How will you ensure that participants can safely leave the site in a socially distanced way?***

Coaches to use walkie-talkies, one coach to greet and ask for who they are collecting, 2<sup>nd</sup> coach to guide and direct parents, and 3<sup>rd</sup> upstairs to send the child downstairs who is being collected, with parents to wait outside.

***How will you clean any equipment (i.e mini tennis nets, orange lines and scoreboards)?***

Coaches to wipe down equipment at the end of each day with anti-bacterial spray and wipes.

***How will you prevent large groups from congregating after the event?***

Once the child has been collected by the parent they will be asked to leave the site promptly.
