Members' Rules and Regulations

- 1. These courts are privately owned and maintained through membership to Grundisburgh Tennis Club. All non-members must pay a court fee to play.
- 2. The courts are to be kept padlocked when not in use. All users must book a court using the weblinks on the club website or via the LTA Clubspark Booker app. The current access pin code for the gate is revealed upon successful booking and provided in the email confirmation to you. If you are last to leave the courts, please ensure they are locked.
- 3. Please note, supervision of juniors is not provided by the club so parents/guardians must provide an appropriate level of supervision. The LTA recommends that children under 13 are supervised by their parents/guardians whilst at the club and outside of any organised activity, such as coaching lessons.
- 4. The club recommends that juniors/vulnerable persons are not left on the courts unsupervised.
- 5. Courts are not available when in use for lessons or matches. Times are posted on website booking diary.
- 6. Club sessions are arranged for members details can be found on the club website or leaflet.
- 7. Members may take a guest three times per year upon payment of the current guest fee. Online payment can be made at the time of booking.
- 8. The current fees for membership can be found on the club website or leaflet.
- 9. Please take any rubbish home with you.
- 10. Only trainers or tennis shoes with non-marking soles to be worn on the courts.
- 11. Members can be expelled from the club by the committee should they be found guilty of conduct prejudicial to the interests or welfare of the club.
