Policy Statement

Harrogate Racquets Club acknowledges the duty of care to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and young people and is committed to ensuring safeguarding practice reflects statutory responsibilities, government guidance and complies with best practice as outlined in the policies of Badminton England, Table Tennis England, The Lawn Tennis Association and North Yorkshire County Council.

The policy recognises that the welfare and interests of children are paramount in all circumstances. It aims to ensure that regardless of age, gender, religion or beliefs, ethnicity, disability, sexual orientation or socio-economic background, all children:

- have a positive and enjoyable experience of sport at Harrogate Racquets Club in a safe and child centered environment
- are protected from abuse whilst participating in badminton, table tennis or tennis or outside of the activity.

• <u>Policy Aims</u>

As part of our safeguarding policy Harrogate Racquets Club will:

- promote and prioritise the safety and wellbeing of children and young people.
- ensure everyone understands their roles and responsibilities in respect of safeguarding and is provided with appropriate education/training to recognise, identify and respond to signs of abuse and other safeguarding concerns relating to children and young people.
- ensure that all staff and volunteers working in badminton, table tennis and tennis are aware of their responsibility to report concerns to a Club Safeguarding Officer.
- ensure that all suspicions and allegations of abuse and poor practice are taken seriously and responded to swiftly and appropriately.
- ensure appropriate action is taken in the event of incidents/concerns of abuse and support provided to the individual/s who raise or disclose the concern.
- ensure that confidential, detailed and accurate records of all safeguarding concerns are maintained and securely stored.
- prevent the employment/deployment of unsuitable individuals.
- ensure robust safeguarding arrangements and procedures are in operation.
- Harrogate Racquets Club will work in close partnership with children, young people and parent/guardians to review and implement child protection and safeguarding procedures.

Responsibilities

- This policy will be available to and adhered by all members, parents/guardians, staff, volunteers and participants.
- The organisation's Safeguarding Officer has responsibility for responding to any allegations, concerns or child protection incidents, passing information to and liaising with the Lead Safeguarding Officers of Badminton England, Table Tennis England, The Lawn Tennis Association and North Yorkshire County Council.

- Members, Parents/Guardians, staff, volunteers and participants all have a responsibility to work together with the organisation in implementing procedures.
- The policy and procedures will be widely promoted and are mandatory for everyone involved in Harrogate Racquets Club. Failure to comply with the policy and procedures will be addressed without delay and may ultimately result in dismissal/exclusion from the organisation.

Monitoring

The policy will be reviewed annually or in the following circumstances:

- changes in legislation and/or government guidance.
- as required by the Local Safeguarding Children Board, UK Sport and/or Badminton England, Table Tennis England, The Lawn Tennis Association and North Yorkshire County Council.
- as a result of any other significant change or event.
