Hauxton Tennis

Rules

Booking courts

All players must pay either on a 'pay-as-you-go' basis or for an annual subscription (membership).

All booking must be made online, using the ClubSpark booking system on the Hauxton Tennis website.

Court booking periods (slots) are for 60 minutes each, starting and finishing on the hour.

Any one player can make up to 2 bookings per day, and up to a maximum of 5 bookings per 7 day period. Each booking is for 1 hour maximum.

Families, couples and groups of players are similarly asked to restrict bookings to no more than 2 hours per day.

If players make multiple future bookings it is expected that they will cancel any that they cannot attend, to free up the courts for other users.

Access to the courts is by a combination lock on the gate. Players must not share the code with others who are not members.

Guests

Members may invite a single guest to play, but after 4 occasions it is required that the guest will either pay for an annual subscription, or book subsequent games themselves on a 'pay-as-you-go' basis.

Use of private coaches

Players may bring their private coaches onto the courts for tuition, but any booking for coaching must be made by the client player, not by the coach.

Coaches wishing to use the courts for regular coaching sessions are required to make themselves known to the Chair of Hauxton Tennis and to pay an annual 'coaching fee' of £75, rather than a membership fee. This will be reviewed annually.

General housekeeping

Please use the litter bins provided or take your litter home. The bins provided on the sports ground are intended for recycling. If you have non-recyclable items such as old tennis balls, please use the bin beside the yellow gate.

Cycles should not be taken on court, nor leant up against the perimeter fencing. Cycle shelters are provided at the pedestrian entrance and beside the car park.
