## **Membership Stats**

We're over halfway through the membership year and thought you might be interested in some stats about our membership:


- · We currently have 413 active members
- 34 have joined since July 1 this year
- · 277 are adults (25 or over), 107 are Juniors (Under 18) and 29 are Young Adults (18-24)
- We have 10 social members
- Our oldest active (not necessarily playing) member is 93 and the youngest is 5 years and 11 months. The average age across all members is a little under 45.
- The revenue for this membership year will total a little over £69,000. 274 members have chosen to pay annually and 106 monthly. The other 29 are lifetime and honorary members.
- 169 of you have paid by Direct Debit, 205 by bank card and10 by direct bank payment. The shift from bank payment to card has been very helpful, thank you





# CLUB AND GROUNDS UPDATE
