## Pickleball Courts & Equipment: Guide

Pickleball can be played on either Court 2 or 3.

There is a dedicated pickleball court next to the children's play area, this is shown as Court 3 on the online booking sheet. Court 2 can also be used as there is a pickleball court marked out in blue.

When using <u>Court 3</u> players will have to put the net up and take it down, instructions are in the bag. Should the court be booked before you, then the net doesn't have to be assembled, and if there is a game booked immediately after yours leave the net up, if not, please take down and put in storage box along with all the other equipment. Lock and return keys to key safe.

When using <u>Court 2</u>, a pickleball court has been permanently marked out with blue lines. The tennis net will have to be lowered to 34 inches at the centre. A measuring stick is kept near the key safe.

The pickleball net, paddles and balls are kept in a secure locked storage box adjacent to the court, bright yellow with a black lid. The keys are kept in a key safe on the back of the rebound court by Court 3, if you do not know the code then please email Sarah on <a href="mailto:biccul@aol.com">biccul@aol.com</a> and Heather <a href="mailto:newman279@btinternet.com">newman279@btinternet.com</a> once a booking has been made. Unfortunately, juniors are unable to play pickleball free of charge as a charge must be made to cover the hire of the equipment. **An adult must book and pay** for a court and supervise play. Juniors may play free of charge on Court2 only if they have their own equipment.

If by chance someone else is playing on the court that you have booked, ask them politely to leave as you have booked and paid for the court.
