Hull YPI Tennis Club has been running for over 100 years and was once the biggest tennis club in Europe. Our club offers, children and adults the opportunity to improve their tennis skills with our professional coaching team, socialise with other members in our club house, pay and play with some friends for a bit of fun or to improve your fitness with our cardio tennis programme. Our club has 3 astro-turf courts, 6 grass courts and a club house.

We are very proud of our achievements and the hard work of a lot of people that even led to on-court success of winning the Hull and District Ladies League in 2018. We have 3 very strong teams for men's, ladies and mixed that travel around Hull and East Riding competing against other clubs in the Hull and District League and the Winter League.

The passion and commitment put into the club by many members now mean we have on average 60 players that come and play tennis on a weekly basis. However there are many expenses connected with running the club and we rely on our own fundraising events and the support of local businesses.

The major expense for the club is paying the rent and the upkeep costs of the tennis courts and clubhouse. We were hoping that this might be something you would consider helping us with.

We are seeking £200 for a year of sponsorship funding. This would be seen by an average of 70+ members of the club, plus pay and play players, other club members on fixture days, spectators and passers-by.
