



Court Rules

The tennis courts shall be available for play each day of the week subject to the conditions below. However, court priority is given to club team matches, identified on the online booking system. Court 1 is next to the A5, Court 2 is next to Hall Close.

The courts shall be locked at all times when not in use. The last person using the courts is responsible for locking the gate.

Before playing, members are requested to clear the courts of any loose leaves using the drag net provided. Collected leaves should be deposited in the bin next to the shed. Also, please sweep the courts with the court brush either before or after playing.

The gate to the courts is secured with a combination lock. The code number will be given to all members on payment of the annual subscription.

There shall be no other games than tennis played on the courts.

Tennis shoes must be worn on the courts at all times.

The club is under no obligation to provide tennis balls except on club night/club morning and for team matches.

Tuesday evenings and Sunday mornings are reserved for adult club sessions. Junior members may play by agreement. Club Nights/Mornings should wherever possible be a Mixed Doubles format.

Courts are available to both adult and junior members at all other times except when club tournament matches, league matches or pre-arranged tournaments are being played.

Court bookings must be made through the online system. The maximum time a court may be booked is 2 hours and booked no more than 4 weeks in advance. If a booking has not been made then members may be asked to vacate the court. Courts no longer needed must be cancelled.

Visitors must be accompanied by a member and pay a fee of£3 for adults and 50p for juniors.

Members are held responsible for the behaviour of their guest(s) and for the collection and payment of the fee to the Treasurer.

Any person infringing these rules or misusing the facilities provided may be banned from playing on the courts by decision of the committee.
