- The club has procedures in place to help any young person or vulnerable adult who requests help and support on a confidential basis, in issues relating to Child & Vulnerable Adults Protection
- The club will ensure that the coaching staff hold an LTA Coach License and have a PVG.
- The club will ensure that any club members and volunteers working with young people & vulnerable adults are aware of and apply the LTA Code of Conduct for Those Working with Children & Vulnerable Adults in Tennis.
- The club has an adult member who is specifically responsible for young people & vulnerable adults.
