Court Booking Terms of Use



GENERAL

- Non-marking footwear must be worn on courts at all times.
- On leaving the courts, all users must ensure that the gate is securely shut, and all rubbish taken home.
- Any activity other than tennis on the courts is strictly prohibited, including but not limited to football, the riding of bicycles, skateboards and scooters.
- All players and visitors must adhere to all notices, signs and information intended for the safety of you and others.
- Dogs are not permitted on courts, with the exception of guide or service dogs.
- Linslade Tennis Club will seek to reclaim any costs related to the intentional, malicious or negligent damage to property or assets.
- Linslade Tennis Club will not accept responsibility for any injuries incurred during play in any weather/ground conditions.
- Linslade Tennis Club reserves the right to change the Terms of Use at any time
- Access to the mini court is through court 3, please wait for a break in play if court 3 is being used, before accessing the mini court.
- Respect that there are neighbouring houses close by and do not enter their property to retrieve any lost balls.

COURT BOOKINGS

- Court bookings are available on the hour and half hour.
- Court bookings can only be made online.
- All courts must (where relevant) be paid for at the time of making a reservation.
- A floodlight fee applies for bookings after dusk. Floodlights will come on automatically 10 minutes before the booked session starts and will turn off 5 minutes after the booked session ends.
- After booking your court, a unique code will be provided to gain access to the courts for your session.
- The person making the booking must be at least 13 years old, and is responsible for the behaviour of all people playing. There should be a maximum of 4 adults on court at anyone time and any players under 13 are to be supervised at all times.
- A full half-hour fee applies to play that continues for longer than 15 minutes after the booked session (and further full fees for every subsequent occurrence of the above).
- Some courts are reserved in advance for Linslade Tennis Club programmes, events and matches.
- Non-members may book one session of a minimum of one hour and a maximum of two hours per day, up to five days in advance.
- When making a booking as a member, all players in the group for the booking are required to be members. A member may invite a visitor, subject to a visitor's fee (£2 for adults, juniors) being paid. A non-member may play as a visitor up to a maximum of 4 times per year.
- LTA Rally and Clubspark terms & conditions will apply to all bookings

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

- Court bookings may be cancelled up to 2 hours in advance of the start of the booking.
- Where bookings are cancelled within the above cancellation period, an automatic refund will be provided.
