# **House and grounds**

Carried out since October 2023.

**Clubhouse** - Structural survey of balcony.

Recommendations:

- a. Replace bolts supporting the cross beams to the uprights DONE
- b. Keep the drain holes clear in the uprights ground anchors DONE
- c. Paint the balustrade, uprights etc QUOTE & CONTRACTOR SELECTED
- d. Replace the handrail QUOTE & CONTRACTOR SELECTED

e. Electrical work: (i) plastic junction boxes, floodlight columns - court 1. (ii) replacing floodlight on/off button box - courts 4/5. (iii) timer in concrete bunker to turn off floodlights - QUOTE & CONTRACTOR SELECTED

Courts 1-3: Infills (recycled sand) & leaf cleaning on courts 1-3 (Oct 23 & Jan 24)

#### Grounds.

- TFW filled pot holes in car park.
- All retaining bolts in original floodlight columns have been cleaned & re-inserted.
- Stream beyond the bridal path monitored regularly.
- Drainage system from the practice area, alongside court 1 and alongside court 2 has been monitored. During the summer will need resetting the sloping slabs, and concreting the gully along court 2 (only half of it is done.).
- Ivy growing cutback on the trees on the bank overlooking Court 1, the clubhouse, courts 2&3, and the wooded area has been cut back.
- Five Bar Gate the supporting wooden mount for the post box was rotten and had come off the gate. A new one has been produced and fixed back on the gate.

Pathway (for drainage) that has been dug between court 3 and train track will need to be covered as this could be H&S issue, especially with evening socials.

Clive is going to look into colour choices for balcony for committee to choose from.

Clive is going to check if it's financially viable to sift sand.

Thanks to Clive for all his hard work.
