Llantwit Major Tennis Club Member's Code of Conduct (reviewed Mar-24)

Members are required to:

- Respect everyone at all times.
- Safeguard everyone who visits our club.
- Be welcoming, supportive and encouraging.
- Ensure no one is ever made to feel excluded, intimidated, threatened or bullied.
- Be mindful of local residents and users of the adjacent children's play park.
- Refrain from using foul & abusive language.
- Raise any safeguarding concerns with the Welfare Officer.

On Court

- Respect the core values of the sport: Integrity, consideration and politeness.
- Wear suitable athletic clothing and shoes to minimise the risk of injury.
- Do not take glass bottles or containers on to the tennis courts.
- Do not walk on to court when play is in progress.
- Wait for a break in play and pass to the rear of the court.
- Be respectful towards other players.
- Respect the line calls of your opponent. (In the event of a disagreement, replay the point).
- Be mindful of other players waiting to play.
- Acknowledge your opponent/s after the match.
- When finished on court, collect up match balls and equipment.
- Do not leave rubbish / litter on court.

Off Court

- Talk quietly when a match is in progress.
- Keep mobile phones on 'silent' mode.
- Keep the club premises tidy and treat the property with respect. Use the correct bins for recycling and general waste. Remove all food waste from the premises.
- Anti-social behaviour, foul & abusive language, smoking and all criminal activity is strictly forbidden within the confines of the club.
- The last club member (or coach) to leave the clubhouse should ensure that all lights
 and heating are switched off, in accordance with the closedown procedure displayed
 on the door, then lock the door and replace the key in the key press adjacent to
 Court 1.
- The last player to leave the courts should lock the external gate and key-press.
