The Open Tournament

Open to all players

The Division 2 to 3 Tournament (with automatic handicap)

Restricted to those playing in Division 2 to 3 of the Lowestoft and District Tennis League. This section of the tournament is designed to encourage other players to enter and experience the competitive edge provided by a tournament.

The Veterans Tournament

Open to all present and past members of the league aged 50 and over (45 and over for singles). This section caters for the players who want to continue to challenge other players of similar age. These matches are well supported and provide the opportunity for these players to compete against each other.

The Open Junior Tournament

Designed for juniors who are new to the experience of open competition.

The Venue

Lowestoft Town Tennis Club has 4 floodlit tennis courts with a tarmac surface which are in very good playing condition

CONDITIONS AND RULES OF ENTRY

- The Tournament will be conducted under the present rules of the Lowestoft & District Tennis League (save for any changes included in these rules of entry).
- All Open matches will consist of two sets. A Tie Breaker will operate at 6-6 in each set. At one set all the match will be decided by a Championship Tie Break (first to 10 points with 2 clear points).
- All Handicap events will be scored as the Open events but will have an automatic handicap system as below:
 All pairs entering will begin play at 0-0. The matches will be played with the following outcomes
 - 'Pair A' wins the first game of the set then 'Pair B' will start 15-0 up in game 2 of the set.
 - 'Pair A' win the second game of the set then 'Pair B' will begin game 3 of the set at 30-0 up (30-0 is the maximum score that can be achieved to start a game)
 - 'Pair B' win the second game of the set in which case the starting score for game 3 will be 0-0
- 4 Open Junior events. (depending on number of entries)
 - All events as a minimum will operate as a round robin with a minimum of 4 entries with the top 2 players (who have accumulated the most games across their qualification rounds) competing in a final on Finals day
 - If enough entries are received the draw will change to a compass draw in which case an East & West format will operate where if a player gets eliminated in round 1 of the East draw then they will revert to the West side draw and continue progress until being knocked out or winning the West side of the draw. Finals for both the East and West Draw will be played on the morning of Finals day
 - All sets will be played under Fast4 rules (best of 3 faster sets with the third 'set' being a championship tiebreak. On court assistants will be present when playing, to help with scoring.
- 5 Competitors drawn to play on the first two days will be notified of their match date and times.
- For all other matches, it is the responsibility of each player to find out when they are required to play their first and any subsequent matches.
- The match date and times for all other games will be posted as soon as possible at the Referees Table. No other official notification will be given.
- 8 Competitors are requested to report their arrival at the Referees Table 10 minutes before the time of their match.
- There will be a period of 10 minutes allocated for a knock-up at the start of each match. Competitors arriving late may be denied the opportunity of the knock-up.
- 10 Competitors who are absent when called upon to play may be disqualified.
- 11 Competitors are expected to play on the first Monday and Tuesday and be available to play at any time on finals day.
- 12 Play on weekdays commences at 5.45pm and on Saturday at 9.00am.
- 13 The Tournament Committee's decision is final in all matters.
- 14 Replica trophies will be presented between finals at the Lowestoft Town Tennis Club on Saturday 24 June 2023.
- All challenge cups and trophies **will only** be presented to winners who are members of the Lowestoft and District Tennis League, at the discretion of the Tournament Committee, and upon proof of suitable cover in an appropriate insurance
- No entry will be accepted after Tuesday 13th June 2023
- 17 No player will be allowed to play in their first match unless their entry fee(s) has/have been paid.
