



Manor Road Protocol for Junior Players 21 March 2021 – Issue 1

This document supports the main document for restricted play entitled “Manor Road Rules & Guidance for Managed Play” and provides additional advice for junior players

All activity at the Club shall be consistent with current government and LTA guidance regarding health, travel, social distancing and hygiene at all times

POLICY FOR JUNIORS FOR RESTRICTED PLAY

- All junior players (under age of 18) must be supervised at all time.
- Parents/guardian are responsible for assessing and providing the level of supervision required to ensure junior players understand and comply with the COVID-safe rules in the above said document
- Supervision during coaching session is limited to one adult per child. Social distance must be observed whenever possible.

COURT BOOKINGS

- Junior members cannot book courts. Parents/guardians must book the courts for them and provide supervision during their session.
- Junior visitors can only be invited by an adult member. The adult member who invited junior players will be responsible for providing supervision and responsible for the safety and wellbeing of that junior player/s

MAINTAINING FACILITIES

- Supervising adult must make sure the court being played on is dragged at the end of play. Bring disposable gloves or sanitiser for use before and after handling drag nets.
- The last adult leaving the site must ensure the Clubhouse and the main gate is locked and the code scabbled
