We are expecting the clubhouse to be completed by mid-May (except for the top floor)

A big thank you to Sarah Ensor for putting up the auction lot of tennis and lunch at Queens Club. We raised £500 thanks to a generous bid from James Sheppard. We now have just £900 to raise for the



initial phase, with two auctions coming out. Thanks to everyone who has helped. The final push is on, so...donate here! Here's what's next for the new build:

- Balcony work, cladding, lighting, and all electricals completed. Internal painting by volunteers -thanks all.
- Pavement area rebuilt, and restoration of the grassed area.
- Removal of the old pavilion when the new building is completed, expected by 17 May.
- Kitchen grant bids are in with final funding decisions and installation from mid-June.







The building site remains out of bounds until it is complete. We do have some Trustees needing access to agree minor changes. The top floor represents a safety hazard as it currently has no strong safety barrier, so please keep off.

You might be curious ...what does the top floor look like? It's progressing. Here is a 'sneak a peek' at the ongoing build. The kitchen image here is a designers visualisation, a single example only of a mocked-up kitchen. We will be making best use of the open space to ensure it is multi-purpose.
