
How to top-up your Golf Clubcard

As a member of Marlborough Tennis, we will issue you a complimentary Golf Club member Clubcard should you opt in. This is a new benefit available to all members. Members of Marlborough Tennis who are already Golf Club members should use their existing Golf Club card. The Clubcard can be used:

- > To purchase bar snack food and beverages in the Clubhouse with a discount of 12%
- In coming months Marlborough Tennis will seek to expand the number of participating organisations offering either a discount or other complimentary benefit and by showing your card you will both save and support local businesses at the same time

To top-up your members Clubcard here is a guide to help:

- 1. Log on to the Golf Club members website portal or member App
- 2. On the top ribbon you will see "MY GOLF" click on MY GOLF
- 3. Then you will be "MY ACCOUNT" click on MY ACCOUNT
- 4. This will show your Clubcard balance, transaction history and options to top-up funds as follows: £10, £20, £30, £50, £100



5. Click on the amount you wish to top-up which takes you to a screen to add a debit or credit card.

Once you have added a payment card you have the facility to save the card details. This fally enables you to avoid adding your card details again when topping up each time.

This platform is 100% secure and links to Clear Accept, our card services provider. Marlborough Golf Club do not have any visibility of your card details and conforms to regulatory conditions of the FSA.

Use your Clubcard to purchase all food and beverages at our club. Please note that members will receive a 12% discount on all beverages purchased using your Clubcard, and 12% on food purchased from the Clubhouse menu. Members discounts do not apply to Sunday carvery and event meals which are priced competitively.

NB: From January 2022 the Golf Club will be a cashless club and produce it to staff when purchasing from their bar. If you have any difficulties, please contact Andrew Payne
