

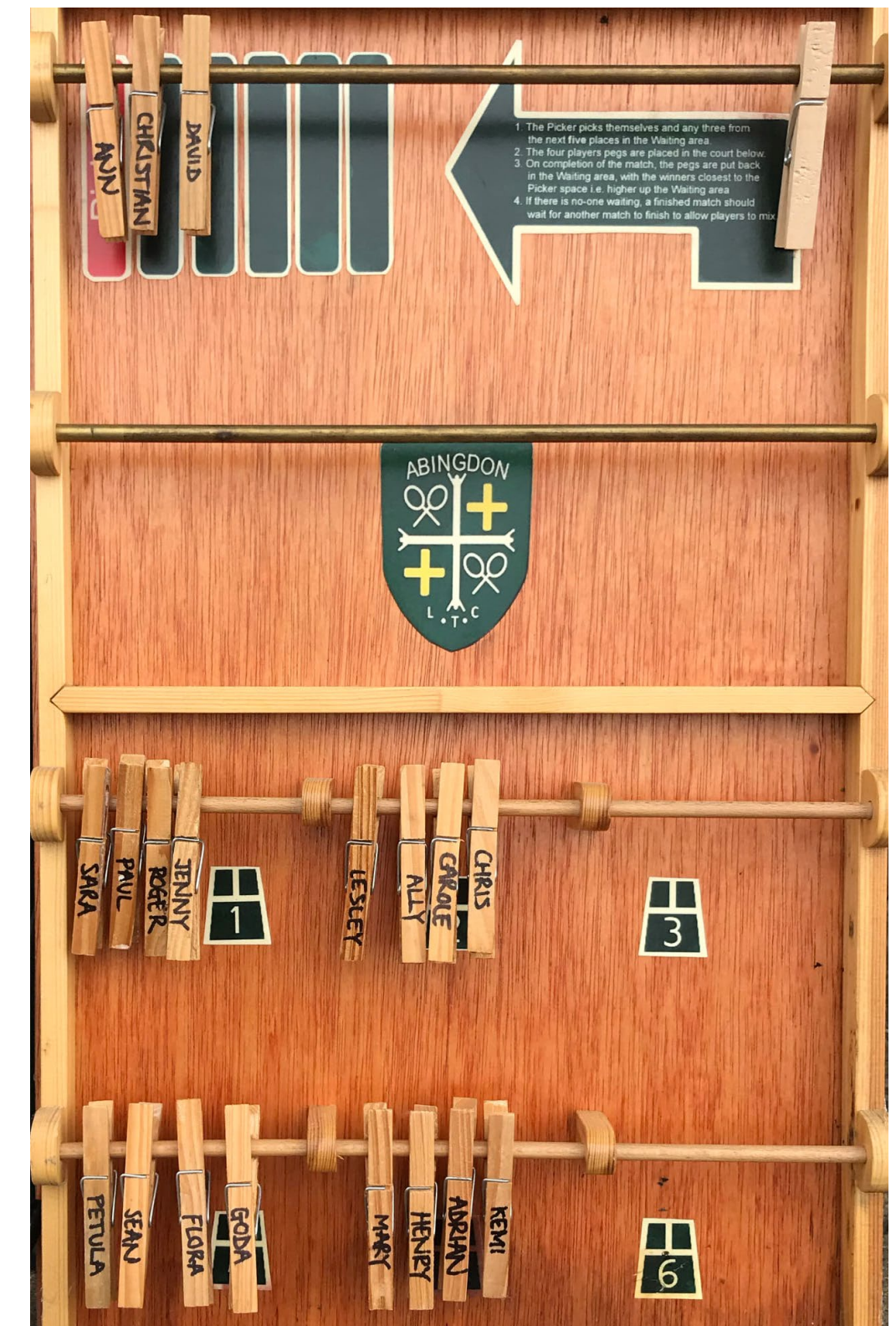
SATURDAY SOCIAL FORMAT

Guidelines:

- Different format to other socials, aimed at allowing more competitive play, while still mixing up play
- Uses a pegboard system with winners playing winners, losers playing losers
- If there are enough players, then mixed doubles will always be played
- First players to arrive are the first to play

Using the peg board:

- Every player present has a numbered peg, which will be placed on the Waiting Section of the board. Players in Waiting Section have preference. Numbers and names are recorded on a list.
- When a player's peg reaches the front of the Waiting Section, they can choose themselves and the other three players from the Waiting Section or the Winners or Losers section to go to the next free court, always trying to set up a mixed match.
- If there are no players in the Waiting Section, then the person at the front of the Winners Section chooses the next four from the Winners Section, always trying to set up a mixed match, followed by person at the front of the Losers Section.
- Each match is one set or max 8 games, with sudden death match point if match is tied at 4-4. Sudden death deuces.
- Winners then go to the back of the Winners Section of the pegboard and losers to the back of the Losers Section.
- Should a player decide to miss a round, they must remove their peg from the board and replace themselves at the BACK of the line when they wish to rejoin.
- People coming off court should go onto the board nearest the right-hand side and then they will move up towards the left (front).
- Duty member will monitor the use to ensure payers are all mixed in and not sitting out excessively
- Tea and cake/biscuits will be available for those sitting out.
