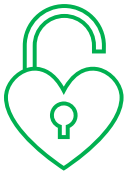


Top tips



Safety

Fire extinguishers are on both floors. We have an integrated fire alarm system which is tested weekly. Do not remove any fire system keys and system instructions are inside the fire alarm box. Additional safety items are on the top floor, and we have a First Aid kit and defibrillator available. Use all facilities at your own risk. Please always keep juniors safe.



Lock boxes

Separate lock boxes are located beside the clubhouse. Always lock up and put the keys back in the appropriate box. Codes are regularly updated. Each set of doors has its own unique set of keys. It is not one size fits all.



Storeroom

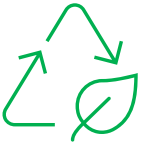
The storeroom is for the coaches and Club equipment including tennis balls, racquets, training equipment and club marketing materials. If you open it, please lock it. The ball machine will be available on the ground floor.





Cleaning

We have previously had cleaning team. But this building needs a rethink. Do your bit. Take bottles and rubbish home. Leave surfaces clean. Only clean the floor with COLD water – it will lift the tiles! The dishwasher has tablets and rinse aid provided. Dishwater instructions are provided nearby.



Recycling

We are in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The clubhouse has been designed to support this. Recycle tennis balls, switch off lights when not in use and take away your rubbish.



Sizzle in the Kitchen

We have a fully fitted kitchen with kettle, oven, coffee machines, fridge freezer and dishwasher. Bring some coffee pods in if you are a coffee drinker and help any guests. The microwave is in a cupboard – get it out if you need it.





Private events

We will be able to host private events subject to further planning. We need to develop guidance for users, booking requirements and insurance. Initially this option is available to members only by advance booking and select community groups once we are fully prepared.

Volunteer



We always need volunteers! Here are some little jobs that take just a small amount of your time:

Just a minute: Sort tennis balls, take away rubbish, wipe up the kitchen, clean the fridge, or empty the dishwasher.

Just five minutes: Clean the loos or mop a floor using cold water only and floor cleaner. Or get on your hands and knees and wipe it with a cloth.

Just ten minutes: Wipe down the windows.

Just 30 minutes: Volunteer to help on a regular rota or gardening/team tidy day to blitz clean the clubhouse.



Own it, Love it, Volunteer!

We've made a long-term investment in the new clubhouse. Treat it like your home and enjoy it to the fullest. Bring friends and guests into the clubhouse. Keep it tidy. We are powered by volunteers; we always need people to help. If anything gets damaged let us know as soon as possible.

The top floor has a fit-out funding gap of £5k.

The next six months

The clubhouse is ready to use. It looks great and there are some finishing touches to come. We still have funds to raise to be fully complete and here is what's planned as additional improvements:

- 🔧 The snagging list developed with our builders
- 🔧 The grounds will be repaired
- 🔧 Wi-Fi will be installed; this is tricky as reception isn't great!
- 🔧 Additional furniture will be provided
- 🔧 A TV will be installed for coaching and general use
- 🔧 Security cameras will be operational
- 🔧 Window blinds/shutters will be installed, possibly electric
- 🔧 A storage solution for our tennis balls/kit will be provided
- 🔧 The bike racks will be restored
- 🔧 A top floor booking system will be added via ClubSpark
- 🔧 Our regular member survey will identify other small improvements members want to see
