New Pavilion update

Marlborough Town Council have approved the initial planning application so we are now progressing to the next stage with Wiltshire Council. Many thanks to Gary Bond for all his hard work on progressing this exciting project.

You might have also spotted some new trellis which has been installed around courts 3-4. This is to reduce the risk of falling from height (for small children) and there is also a new fire extinguisher in the pavilion. This is as result of our annual site safety review (part of an annual LTA Registration process.) We also have a bid in for a defibrillator with the Town Council Funds with a decision expected in January. We may need a few first aiders to be trained up. If you are already qualified please let <u>Anne Carroll</u> know. The Golf Club always has qualified staff if needed who can help in the event of emergency.

World Tennis Number

The LTA have partnered with the ITF to launch the World Tennis Number (along with other global tennis federations). The ITF World Tennis Number will replace the current LTA Ratings system, creating a global player

standard to enable more appropriate matches between players of similar



levels from recreational to professional tennis. Within Wiltshire this number will become a requirement for league players later this year.
