

## MH Tennis Parent/ Guardians Safeguarding Overview

\*Below is an overview of our code of conduct for parents and guardians of children that take part in activities as part of MH Tennis. All parents/guardians and required to read and follow the full safeguarding policy set out.

- All Parents and Guardians must positively reinforce their child, using appropriate language at all times, and setting a good example of behaviour and attitude at all times.
- All parents and guardians must respect other parents/ children and coaches, and must not interfere negatively in coaching sessions, events, camps or competitions.
- All parents and guardians must drop off and collect their child on time, and are responsible for their child before the session starts, and after the session has ended.
- All parents are responsible in making sure their child attends activities in appropriate clothing, with necessary refreshments, and also make sure their child does not require the toilet.
- We understand that parents/guardians want to take photos of their child taking part
  in activities. We encourage this as part of positively reinforcing tennis as an activity,
  and saving memories of your child's accomplishments. However, it is asked that any
  photo's of other children are not posted online, unless consent has been given from
  the appropriate person.
