

One Hundred Club Rules

PURPOSE

The purpose of the MTC 100 Club is to raise funds for the new tennis courts and their ongoing maintenance. 70% of the money will be paid into the MTC fund raising account and 30% of the money raised will be returned as prize money.

RULES

- 1. The 100 Club will be run under the supervision of the Melbourne Tennis Club who will also administer the club. In case of any dispute the decision of the Club Committee is final
- 2. The MTC 100 Club is a Private Society Lottery and is only open to club members, aged over 16 years. It is not open to non-members
- 3. For a cost of £12 per year you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100. Members may buy more than one number
- 4. Entry will be by subscription of £1 per month, per number, paid in advance and based on a minimum period of twelve months (£12 per number per annum)
- 5. The draw will be monthly and there will be one lucky winner each month, drawn on or around the last Friday of the month
- 6. The prize** will total 30% of the month's income
- 7. All winnings will be paid by electronic bank transfer (BACS)
- 8. The monthly winner will be contacted personally, and the results will appear on the MTC website each month after the draw
- 9. A record will be kept recording the name of each member, email address and the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them
- 10. Member's numbers will only be entered into the draw if their membership subscription is up to date
- 11. The draw will be made each month by the 100 Club co-ordinator, Pat Milham
- 12. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month
- 13. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the MTC fundraising account after six months

** If 100 numbers are sold then the monthly prize will be £30
