## Terms and Conditions of Membership of Meldreth Tennis Club (2021)

1. To play tennis at Meldreth Tennis Club you must be a current Full Member of the Club. Full membership enables you to:

- a) Attend Club sessions & club social events (see diary on the website & notice board)
- b) Book courts for social play (subject to availability)
- c) Play in Club teams (subject to selection)
- d) Play in Club tournaments (may be subject to selection)

Only the following exceptions apply:

- Competitors from other Clubs I.e. on court during inter-club matches
- Potential New Members I.e. trying out the Club for a maximum of 3 visits after which they are required to join.
- Paying guests of Full Members, who have paid the Guest Fee

2. Membership of the club is conditional on acceptance of, and compliance with, the Club Constitution, the Club Policies and the Codes of Conduct, which are all available on the Club website or from the Club Secretary.

3. If you become aware of what you would consider anti-social behaviour or conduct that infringes Club Policies or Club Codes of Conduct (or indeed anything against the spirit of the Club) please inform the Chairman or Secretary.

4. Membership is for the full club-year and is non-refundable (however in exceptional circumstances a partial refund may be made at the sole discretion of the Membership Secretary). If you join the club half-way through the year then you will pay a pro-rata membership price. Contact the Membership Secretary for details.

5. Use of the courts is at your own risk. The courts are kept to a regular maintenance programme however weather conditions mean that at times the courts can become slippery. Appropriate footwear should always be worn and care should be taken to avoid injury to yourself and/or others. A First Aid kit is available for club members in the box on court 2.

6. The Pavilion on the recreation ground is available to club members attending matches to use the toilets and the kitchen for match teas. Contact the match secretary to obtain the key. Users of the pavilion are responsible for its' safe use, leaving it clean & tidy and closing and locking it after use.

7. If you are the last to leave the courts then it is your responsibility to ensure that the gates are padlocked and secured. Please ensure that you leave the courts as you would like to find them. In particular please take care to remove any litter that you might see.

8. A key for access to the courts is available for a fee. Members with a key are responsible for its' safe-keeping and sole use; it must not be lent to anyone else for use, nor copied or duplicated. Contact the membership secretary for details and costs. Locks are changed regularly; you will be notified of this and your key will be swapped for the current version there is no charge for this.

9. Children of 13 years or older may play tennis unsupervised on the courts but only in accordance with The Club Juniors on Court Policy.

11. Meldreth Tennis Club will maintain a confidential database of members, including names, email addresses, postal addresses and telephone numbers; acting always in accordance with the Club Data Protection Policy. Note that MTC members registered with the British Lawn Tennis Association (LTA), who have a British Tennis Membership number, are eligible for the annual draw for Wimbledon tickets to purchase. The Wimbledon draw is administered directly by the LTA through their website.
