## Much Hadham Tennis Club Rules

- 1. In the event that all the courts are in use, players who have been on court for one hour or more should give up their court.
- 2. Juniors may not operate the floodlights unless accompanied by an Adult Member. Please only illuminate the courts you are playing on to avoid unnecessary use of electricity.
- 3. All players must wear tennis shoes with soft, non-marking soles, NO other footwear is permitted.
- 4. No footballs, bicycles, roller blades or any other form of wheels are allowed on the courts under any circumstances.
- 5. Do not let the nets down after play.
- 6. Secure padlock onto side netting while you play (to avoid losing it) and relock the court door when you leave. If anyone is still playing, please ask them to lock up when they leave. DO NOT lock people in.
- 7. THE SAME GUEST MAY ATTEND THREE TIMES IN ONE YEAR, THEREAFTER THEY ARE REQUIRED TO JOIN AND PAY A SUBSCRIPTION.
- 8. Club sessions will take priority over all courts subject to attendance. Doubles will be played at times when courts are in demand.
- 9. The playing of league matches takes priority over other play on the courts, excluding Club sessions

Do not leave floodlights on where courts are not being used. The lights automatically extinguish at 10.00pm on weekdays and 9.00pm at weekends and Bank Holidays out of respect for our neighbours.

Public liability insurance does not cover non-members unless a committee member has given permission to play. *Their names, addresses, dates and time of play must be provided before play.* Members who have guests but do not pay the supplement for them will be in breach of the Membership Rules and may be liable to have their membership forfeited
