

## Junior Representative Member Role Description

### Overview of the Role

The junior representative can either be a junior over the age of 14 or if an adult, ideally a parent/guardian of a junior player.

### Responsibilities

- The Junior Representative is to represent the U18 members and has a place on the Club Committee.
- Represents the juniors at open days and tournaments.
- Receives enquiries from junior about membership, coaching and competition. Represents these issues to the committee.
- Ensures juniors have available court access and that these can be booked via parents/guardians.
- Ensure juniors are able to play in a safe environment and operate within the club code of conduct.
- Act as a role model for the younger juniors in the club

### Skills and experiences needed for the role

- Ability to Interact with the club coaches to reflect what junior programmes are desired.
- Preferably is a Tennis Leader
