Floodlights

With the winter and dark evenings, this is a reminder about how the floodlights and Smart Gate operate. You must make a court booking for your gate entry code to work. If the booking is for a time when the floodlights should operate (the times change depending on the sunrise and sunset times) then these will come on for your booking. The gate entry code and the lights will start to operate 10 minutes before your booking time and for 5 minutes afterwards.

It is very important that you read and understand the following:

- If you need to extend your play on the court, you MUST make another booking. This is the only way that you will continue to have floodlights.
- If you are unable to use your booking, you MUST cancel it so that the lights do not come on unnecessarily. This is easy to do: click on your booking on the booking sheet, where there is a cancel option. Please help us to keep energy costs down.
- Under no circumstances should you use the override switch in the Clubhouse. This has now been taped up and there is a notice next to it to warn people not to use it. Unfortunately, this has been used inappropriately in the past, so we have had to make it out of bounds.

We are very fortunate that as members we do not have to pay for the floodlights and so far the Club has been able to cover the cost from Members' subscriptions. Please help to keep it that way by being responsible and observing the above.
