DEFIBRILLATOR

Most will be aware of the incident concerning Christian Eriksen at the Euros football match a couple of weeks ago. It is a sobering reminder that sometimes even very fit people can have underlying health issues. A defibrillator was used once on Christian Eriksen and it was widely reported that this saved his life. The quicker a defibrillator is used in such cases, the greater the chance of survival and the less likelihood of long-term damage.

So, it is important that we should all be aware of the location of the defibrillator that serves the Willen Road Sports Ground. It can be found on the outside left-hand wall of the Football Club bar entrance; please take a few moments to check this out the next time you are at the Club. The instructions are very clear and please be assured that defibrillators are easy to use.

COURT BOOKING RULES

Please make sure that you know and understand the booking rules:

- You must make a booking before playing at the courts.
- Each member can make up to 5 one-hour court bookings in any 7-day period. Bookings can be
 made up to 14 days in advance. If you find that you cannot play as planned, please cancel your
 booking so that the court is made available to someone else.
- Please make all bookings on the website (<u>www.newportpagnelltennis.net</u>).
 You must include the names of all those playing on the court, even other members, by clicking on the <u>+Add Participants</u> option at the bottom-left of the booking form.
- Non-member guests are welcome, but you must add their names by using the
 +Add Participants
 option. A fee of £3 is charged for each guest for an hour's booking.
 This needs to be paid by credit card at the time of booking. If you subsequently need to cancel your guest booking, you will receive a refund if you cancel at least 24 hours before the time of your booking slot.
