## **MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS**

We currently have a total of 174 members. This is almost exactly the same as at the same point last year. Like many local outdoor tennis clubs in the last two years, we benefited from people joining when the indoor courts at the David Lloyd Centre were closed. This year, some of the David Lloyd members have not re-joined, so it's good to see that we have not suffered too much as a result. Perhaps people recognise what good value NPTC membership is!

Membership numbers are pretty evenly split between Adults and Juniors (4-17 years). Of the 88 adult members, 42 are women and 46 are men. Of the 86 juniors, 34 are girls and 52 are boys.

Over 80% of our annual income is from membership. This year so far membership income is about £11.5K. So, please spread the word about the benefits of tennis and, especially, what a great Club we are!

### TEAM NEWS

We have several adult teams entered in local leagues for both summer and winter. It's been a mixed bag of results for the matches played in the summer league so far. **The Mixed A team** have had a strong start to the summer, drawing one and winning two matches and are top of MK Division 1 with two matches to play.
