Last weekend Norfolk U12 boys competed in division 2a their annual county cup. The boys were playing at a home venue of Easton College on the clay courts. U12 Captains were Ben Collingwood and Alex Watkinson

The counties in group 2a were; Norfolk, Cambridgeshire, Oxfordshire, Berkshire and Bedfordshire. After a good run at Lionel Cox event back in April the boys were keen to build on their momentum as most will be moving up to U14s age group in the new year.

The next match was against Berkshire, although the score ended 0-6 to Berks, the boys unfortunately found themselves on the receiving end of multiple tiebreak sets that didn't go Norfolks way. However, we had a Norfolk debut at U12 for Sam and George who stepped up in the doubles and competed with great energy and team spirit.

After a team mini golf and meal out on Saturday evening, Norfolk were ready to go again early on Sunday against Cambridshire, a straight sets win for Oscar and Noah lost out in a close 3 set match at number two, Norfolk ended 1-3 down to Cambridgeshire.

Norfolks final match was against Bedfordshire, Wins for Eliott and Oscar in straight sets in the singles at 3 and 4, Noah (again) battling hard in a 3rd set tie break at 2 and winning 12-10 to put Norfolk 3-0 up, Finlay showed great competitive traits in his match against a strong number 1 player from Beds, taking him to a set tiebreak. Norfolk finishing on top the singles at 3-1.

Due to limited time no doubles were played on the second day so the matches were concluded after the singles, Norfolk recorded wins against Oxfordshire and Bedfordshire and losses against Cambridshire and Berkshire.
