NEWSLETTER - TENNIS SEASON 2019/2020

Dear Member,

Welcome to the 2019/2020 season at the Oaks and District Tennis Club.

CLUB TENNIS

During the match season which runs from May to July, Tuesday and Thursday evenings have been designated for Club play BUT please note that Thursday Club Night can only take place when the Ladies DO NOT have a match. A match fixture list and notice to remind us all will be put up in the Clubhouse nearer the time. Also, our website will identify when matches take place. Saturday and Sunday are also available for Club play except when official coaching, matches or tournaments have been organised. After the match season ends, all evenings become available for Club play. Before the Summer League Men's matches begin, all male members representing the Club are invited to men's team practices on Monday or Wednesday evening (to be mixed around) and ladies are invited to their team practice on a Friday evening. Please contact the team Captains for more information.

Club Morning takes place on Wednesday from 10.00am onwards in winter and 9.30am onwards in Summer and non-members are welcomed for a fee of £3 on six occasions. Club play is also designated on a Saturday afternoon from 2.00 pm onwards. Club play also takes place on Tuesday evenings, 5.30pm onwards in winter and 6pm onwards in Summer. Please contact a Committee member and/or the website about times for Thursday evening club play.

SUMMER LEAGUE MATCH TENNIS

Any ladies interested in playing in the Summer League should contact Janet Braithwaite, Team Captain or Maz Gourley, Vice Captain. Ladies League matches take place at home normally on Thursday evenings or away on any weekday evening during the summer from May onwards.

Any men interested in playing in the Summer League should contact Martin Croft, Team Captain or Derek Lister, Vice Captain. One Men's team will play Summer League matches in Division 7 (home matches Monday or Wednesday) with priority for younger players and new for this year is a Senior Team (anyone reaching the age of 45 or over in 2019 is eligible to play in this team) days and dates are still to be finalised. The advantage is, playing in the Senior team does not preclude playing in the Division 7 Summer league team.

Match fixtures and times will be placed on the website notice board when they are received from the LTA, (Lawn Tennis Association) and teams picked at a later date when player availability is known.

Historically the Parent Membership category only allows parents to play with their children, and only with children who attend coaching sessions organised at the club.

TO ENCOURAGE NEW MEMBERS THE CLUB IS INITIATING A 'PAY AS YOU GO' SYSTEM WHICH WOULD INCLUDE SIX VISITS TO THE CLUB. THE COST OF THESE VISITS WOULD BE DEDUCTED FROM ANY SUBSEQUENT MEMBERSHIP PAID IN THE SAME YEAR.

Fees reduce by one twelfth from 1 July until the end of the next year

NB: Before a person may play as a visitor, his/her name must be entered in the visitor's book.

Please look after the balls and retrieve them if they go out of the courts. Please return them to the clubhouse when you have finished playing with them.

BRITISH TENNIS MEMBERSHIP (BTM)

For those of you who have not signed up for BTM the membership is still free for the time being. Anyone wishing to play competitive tennis must be a BTM, as you must register your results with BTM to get your LTA rating. Register on-line, the website is www.lta.org.uk/BritishTennisMembership. Benefits include, advice from top coaches and players, exclusive discounts, player ratings, online tournament entry, monthly e-newsletter and entry into the Wimbledon ticket draw at the club.

MAINTENANCE OF CLUBHOUSE AND GROUNDS

Whilst at the clubhouse it is appreciated if all members help to keep the clubhouse and grounds clean and tidy. **PLEASE TAKE YOUR RUBBISH HOME WITH YOU**, the tennis club **does not** have a dustbin collection facility.
