

Ramsbury Tennis Club Regulations as at January 2022

- 1. The Club shall be open for play 365 days a year. However, the Committee has the power to close the Courts for maintenance or other special reasons.
- 2. All categories of Members, except Ramsbury Hotshots, shall be entitled to hold a key card for access to the Pavilion which shall be issued upon payment of the annual subscription. Lost key cards will be replaced at the discretion of the Treasurer upon the appropriate payment for a replacement key card.
- 3. The Club has adopted a Safeguarding Policy for the protection of all its members which is published on the Club's website. In becoming Club members all members are deemed to have notice of the Safeguarding Policy and are deemed to accept its provisions and will conduct themselves in accordance with it.
- 4. Courts may be booked upon the terms and conditions set out in the Booking Regulations from time to time passed by the Committee and displayed on the Website.
- 5. Club tournaments, matches, coaching and other organised Club events will be advertised on the website/by email or as the Committee shall from time to time direct.
- 6. Club sessions will be on days and at a time advised by the Committee. Balls will be provided by a Committee Member.
- 7. Only recognised tennis shoes without raised heels, studs, bars or deep ribbing may be worn.
- 8. Members wishing to play on Courts Three and Four shall use the gate on Court Four for access. The courts are locked with a combination lock and fully paid members will be given the combination which will be changed by the Committee from time to time.
- 9. The last person to leave the Courts is to ensure that any measuring sticks are put in the Pavilion, floodlights turned off, and the Pavilion and courts locked. Please also remove all water bottles and other rubbish from the courts and place them in the bins provided.
- Dogs, bicycles and skateboards are not allowed inside the Court area and dogs are not allowed on the sports field. Under no circumstances should anyone ride their bikes or skateboards on the courts.
- 11. Please do not use chewing gum on the Courts.
- 12. The Courts are to be used for playing tennis only. No other ball games are permitted.
- 13. The Club Notice Boards shall not be defaced and no notices shall be put on the Club Notice Boards without the consent of the Committee.
- 14. There shall be no smoking within any part of the Court area or the Pavilion.
- 15. No Club member shall give the combination of the court padlocks to any non-member under any circumstances.
- 16. No Club member shall allow a non-member to play except with the member present and even then not more than four times in any calendar year.
- 17. No Club members shall drive their cars along the track between the Courts and the MUGA unless they have specific permission to do so or are delivering supplies to the Pavilion or carrying out works there.

Also, no cars shall be parked by the Pavilion except those belonging to the Coaches or Officers of the Recreation Centre. This is a requirement of the Recreation Centre which owns the facility.

All juniors having coaching or attending courses shall be dropped off in and picked up from the main car park. This is a Health and Safety issue.

These Regulations have been made by the Committee for the benefit of all Club Members.

Please observe them.
