Roade Tennis Club - 100 Club and Community Project

What is a '100 Club'?

The 100 club is a lottery with 100 members only. Each member of the 100 club pays an annual fee of £15 for one share and is then entered into the monthly draw with an opportunity to win a small cash prize each month (1 X £30 and 2 X £10).

What is the aim of the 100 club?

The funds generated from the 100 club will, in part, be used for prizes (£600), but the intention is that the remainder (£900) will be used for a community project to provide a greater level of exposure to tennis for juniors across primary and secondary schools in the area. RTC will provide up to 16 free junior memberships in conjunction with a programme of coaching to introduce them to tennis and develop their skills. The intention is that over time those juniors (and their families) can get involved with RTC and the junior club night could also be re-introduced.

To meet our value of 'inclusivity', we hope to expose our club to a wider community audience and promote playing tennis.

"Play better tennis in a friendly, fun, and inclusive club!"

When and how will it happen?

You will have an opportunity to join the 100 club, via Clubspark, at the time of renewal. The maximum number of 'shares' is 100. You may increase your chances of success by purchasing more than 1 share per member/couple/family.

Thereafter we will draw the lottery monthly on the last Wednesday of each month and post the results through the RTC's whats app groups and email.

At membership renewal time each year members will have an opportunity to renew their membership of the 100 club. We will then seek to repeat the process with ideally, a new group of juniors benefitting and hope that the previous recipients move to continue their membership of the club on the junior programme.
