TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP OF ROADE TENNIS CLUB

When you sign up for membership, or renew an existing membership of the club, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions set out below.

As the principal member, (or parent of members under 18), on behalf of all named individuals in your membership, you agree to:

- abide by Roade Tennis Club's <u>T&Cs</u>, <u>Code of Conduct & Etiquette</u> and other policies (found on our website) necessary for the safe and successful running of the club.
- children under 12 not being left unattended on court **or** in the clubhouse. Parents are responsible for their children at all times. 12–16year-olds are allowed on court unaccompanied, but **not** in the clubhouse unaccompanied.
- take responsibility for your own safety on court and refrain from playing when the weather makes the court surface unsafe to play on.
- record any accidents in the accident book located with the First Aid Box, or report to the committee.
- report any damage to the court, clubhouse, or facilities immediately to the committee.
- inform the club about any special care needs, or medical conditions that could affect the individuals' safety at the club. - ensure that the details of the individuals in your membership are accurate and up to date (including, Date of Births, email addresses and mobile phone numbers).
- ensure that the membership fees are paid in full and on time.
- support the club's events, competitions, fundraising and annual AGM where possible.
- not divulge any of the club's access codes to non-members. (If you believe these have become compromised, notify a member of the committee immediately.)
- photographic images being taken for internal and external promotion of the club, and coaching programme, including our social media.
- Roade Tennis Club using the membership information provided for the purpose of running the club, and you consent to receive information related to your membership of the club by email and SMS/WhatsApp. Our <u>data protection policy</u> is on our website.
