News Headlines

- **The 2024 Season kick-off** went ahead in the sun on Saturday 23rd March with tennis, hot dogs & refreshments. Thanks to James, Paul, Donna & Cath for organising





- **Pavilion Development**



- Phase 1 work involves the development of the downstairs in floodproof materials. Work starts end of April 24 & runs until July 24. This is funded in part by the Tennis Club (£20k) & in part by York City Council (£15k). This will give us:
 - 2 disabled toilets
 - 2 changing rooms
 - Kitchenette
 - Storeroom
 - High shelving for storage (above the floodline)
 - Disability ramp
 - New windows & doors


- **Court Cleaning**

- Courts 1 to 6 were professionally cleaned at the start of March 2024 following floods
- Annoyingly, floodwater has removed some surface paint on Courts 2, 3 & 4 (black patches). These patches are a little unsightly but are not slippery



- **Court Signage**

- 8 new canvas banners (6ft x 3ft) have been ordered for early April to replace the ageing ones currently on display. These will advertise the benefits of Club Membership, highlight the Club philosophy of 'tennis for all', as well as explaining how to join & how to book a court
- Fresh laminated Court Numbers & Welfare information has already been mounted on Courts 1 to 6

How the Club runs


- The Club is run 100% by volunteers

- The Tennis Club receives revenue from public court bookings in return for administering & maintaining (including refurbishment & resurfacing of courts)


Club Communications

Pic: the Rowntree Park Tennis Club website



All court usage is booked through the ClubSpark booking system ([click here](#)). This system allows Members to see when the courts are free and to book courts.

ClubSpark can also be accessed using the 'ClubSpark Booker' App (see below). Go to **Apple App Store** or **Google Play** and search for '**ClubSpark Booker**'.



Court Access Code

The current access code for the gates will continue to operate until the end of April. It will then be changed, and 2024 Members will be advised of the new number.

Club Sessions – just turn up!

We pride ourselves on being a friendly Club and being good at helping new Members feel quickly at home. The focus is on fun & getting to know other players.

Players of all levels of experience including new starters are welcome. We have a wide range of ages, a good mix of male and female players of all abilities and we adapt our play so that everyone settles in readily.

If you are coming along for the first time, we can get a helper to meet up with you before play starts and then introduce you to the others. Just drop an email to help@rowntreeparktennis.org.uk

There are **3 informal tennis get togethers each week with mixed doubles play** where everyone moves around during the session - so you get to play & chat with many different folks.

The 3 sessions run from late March to September:

- **Thursday 6pm to 8pm** on Courts 1 to 4 (the 4 courts near the pavilion & skateboard park)
1st session = 21st March 2024
- **Saturday 2pm to 4pm** on Courts 5 & 6 (the ones near the café)
1st session = 16th March 2024.
- **Sunday 10am to noon** on Courts 3 & 4
1st session = 7th April 2024. Due to League Matches, this session is not possible on all Sundays across the summer. Notifications are sent through WhatsApp

Some folks worry that the standard might be too high, or it will be too 'serious' – **DON'T HESITATE!** Many of us are recent joiners and we had those doubts too! Once you get out on the courts and play for the first time you will realise that everyone is happy to help you enjoy learning and playing the game.

Winter Tennis

Rowntree Park is open for tennis throughout the year (except during floods). During the colder winter months (October to March), there is indoor play too:

- **Mixed Doubles (known as ‘the Bubble group’)**

The Club books 3 indoor courts at the York University Bubble for 2 hours every Sunday morning. Play is informal mixed doubles and is organised through a dedicated WhatsApp Group. If you wish to play, then ask to join the WhatsApp Group by emailing whatsapp@rowntreeparktennis.org.uk

- **Singles (competitive play)**

There is also a Singles League played in the winter months at the same York University Bubble on midweek evenings (matches last 1 hour). This League is administered by Rowntree Park Members but players from other Clubs also take part.

Appendix 1 - Professional Tennis – how is it organised & where can you watch it?

I have recently been asked by several people about where professional tennis tournaments can be watched on TV or online.

The short answer is that you can watch every tournament in every country in every month of the year!

But before explaining the ‘where to watch’ bit, it's worth understanding how global professional tennis is organised.

Professional tennis is run by 2 global organisations:

- ATP (Association of Tennis Professionals) – Men's Tennis
- WTA (Women's Tennis Association) – Women's Tennis

There are 3 different surfaces used:

- Hard court (acrylic)
- Clay
- Grass

There are 4 'blue riband' events in the year & these are referred to as the 'Grand Slams'. These are the only events where Men's matches consist of best of 5 sets. The 'Slams' last a full 2 weeks.

In all other events (& for all Ladies events) matches are best of 3 sets only & the tournament durations are between 7 & 11 days.

Grand Slams:

- Australian Open (late January), Melbourne. Hard court
- French Open aka Roland Garros (May), Paris. Clay court
- Wimbledon (July). Grass court
- US Open (September), New York. Hard court

ATP (Mens) & WTA (Womens) Events:

Professional tennis runs continuously from January to November. So barely a 6 week break from competition. But even then, many of the top players play exhibition tournaments in the Middle East in December to top up their earnings.

Both organisations operate a rolling ranking points system where players gain points for getting through each round of each tournament.

Each tournament is designated a points status:

- (Men's) ATP1000, ATP500 or ATP250
- (Women's) WTA1000, WTA500 or WTA250

The numbers indicate how many ranking points go to the winner. Basically, the top players gravitate towards the 1000 & 500 events because that's where the bigger points are to be harvested.

Ranking points are important because they can guarantee automatic entry into the ATP/WTA tournaments as well as the Grand Slams. Lower ranked players must play qualifying matches or rely on 'wildcard' entry (at the discretion of the tournament organisers).

It is quite common to have 2 or 3 ATP/WTA events running in parallel in different places in the world. So, in a given week, you may have an ATP 500 event running in country x & 2 other ATP 250 events happening in the same week in countries y & z.

TV / online coverage:

- **Grand Slams**
 - Australian Open (late January) - **Eurosport & the Discovery Plus** online app until 2031
 - French Open aka Roland Garros (June) – **Eurosport & the Discovery Plus** online app
 - Wimbledon (July) – **BBC free to air** (use BBC iPlayer to see action from all courts)
 - US Open (September) – **Sky Sports TV** until 2029
- **ATP & WTA events**

Sky Sports signed a deal to show a selection of ATP & WTA tournaments for 5 years starting in 2024.

However, the ATP/WTA organisation has its own online subscription 'TV' channel which shows pretty much every match in every tournament across the year. This is called '**Tennis TV**' & costs £99 for an annual subscription (search 'Tennis TV' on the web). If you have a smart TV you can display ('cast') the channel to your lounge TV.



The other tennis subscription service out there is called '**The Tennis Channel**'. Whilst the USA version of this channel has good content, the European version (International) has thin content & no Grand Slam or ATP/WTA live matches.
