

PARENTS AND SPECTATOR OBLIGATIONS:

- Parents and spectators should adhere to all codes of conduct rules, protection policies, and all related policies, including those issued by LTA.
- Parents and spectators should offer encouragement and applaud good play, effort and performance from both players and opponents.
- Parents and spectators should always remain outside the courts during play and within any designated spectators area.
- Parents and spectators should promote players' sense of personal achievement and self-esteem.
- Parents and spectators should encourage players to improve their skills and techniques.
- Parents and spectators should ensure that players have a positive attitude and show respect to other players, club officials, club coaches, match official, opponents and spectators.
- Parents and spectators should develop an appropriate supportive relationship with both club officials and their son or daughter based on mutual trust and respect. Support the club's decisions and discuss any concerns directly with the club.
- Parents and spectators must never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- Parents and spectators must not coach any player during the game.
- Parents and spectators should encourage players to fulfil the duty of all members to sweep the courts; and clear any debris/ leaves after play.
- Parents and spectators should encourage players to clean up the clubhouse after use.
- Parents and spectators should encourage players to clear away rubbish and to recycle paper and drinks containers glass, plastic etc. in the bins provided.
- Parents and spectators should ensure non-members /visitors fees are paid/ money deposited in the visitors fees box.
