

## Terms and Conditions

### Court Usage

- Courts are available on a “first come first served” basis but formally organised Club events such as matches, Club nights, tournaments and coaching take priority. Anyone who has made a court booking has the next priority followed by players who turn up to play without a booking.
- Court hours are from 8.00 am to 10.00 pm.
- Courts can be booked online up to 7 days in advance at Club’s website or via a Smartphone booking app. Please contact the Club Secretary for further details.
- Court booking for Pickleball should be made in off peak hours, that is between 8.00am to 10.00am Monday to Friday and between 12.00 noon and 4.00pm on any afternoon.
- Courts are only to be used by paid up members, named visitors who have paid the appropriate fee and visiting players playing in league competition and tournaments.
- The Club reserves the right to cancel or amend any bookings made.
- If you are the last one using the courts you should lock them up when you leave.
- The courts are used at your own risk. Please ensure that you take care, especially when the courts are wet or potentially icy/slippery. Only play if you are sure that it is safe to do so. Children under 13 years old using the courts should be supervised by an adult at all times. Children between 13 and 17 years should play only with parental permission.
- Please ensure that any accidents which do occur on or in the vicinity of the courts or clubhouse are entered onto an Accident/Incident Form which are kept in the clubhouse.
- Proper (non-marking) footwear must be worn. If footwear is found to be marking the courts then please stop play.
- Players should wear clothing suitable for sport / tennis.
- If a League match is underway then the spare court can be used for general play.
- Please take care not to over-tighten nets, and lower them at the end of play.
- No chewing gum or glass should be taken onto the courts.
- All rubbish should be placed in the bin provided.
- No bicycles, scooters, roller blades or skate boards should be used on the courts.
- All members using the courts must use the top car park and walk down to the courts on the access road. No parking or dropping off in the lower car park is allowed at any time. Cars are parked at the owners risk.

# Floodlight Usage

- Floodlights are operated by token only. No money is kept in the token meters. One token costs £3 and lasts for 1 hour
- Tokens and the combination to open the floodlight control box are available from the Club Chairperson, Treasurer or Secretary.
- To operate the lights:
  - Open the control box doors via the combination lock and switch on the internal light using the oval white button on the back wall of the box. This light is on a timer and will turn off after around 30 seconds.
  - Open the switch box on the right and switch on the lights for the court required. "On" is left to right.
  - Insert a token into the appropriate meter for the court required. Additional tokens can be inserted if required.
  - Please switch off the lights when play is finished. "Off" is right to left.
  - Please lock the flood light control box when you have finished with it.
- Please note that no person under 16 years old is allowed access to the floodlight control box.
