SAFE USE OF THE TENNIS COURTS

Players should take account of the following before playing

Court condition

- Check the courts and remove any debris/trip hazards
- Report any maintenance issues or concerns to a committee member

Bad weather

- Playing during inclement weather conditions is at a player's own risk
- The courts may be slippery when it is wet
- Playing in icy conditions is inadvisable

Cricket balls

- While cricket is being played on the field beside the tennis courts, cricket balls may be hit into the courts.
- Shillingstone Tennis Club does all it can to ensure the safety of tennis players. It must, however, also be the responsibility of players to safeguard themselves by being alert to this risk.

Under 13's

 As recommended by the LTA, children under the age of 13 are to be supervised by their parent/carer whilst using the courts outside of any club session
