## **FLOODLIGHT TOKENS**


Floodlight tokens can be purchased from the Sports Club bar at a cost of £5 per token - each token gives you an hours worth of lights.

## **COURT USAGE**

# CLUB EVENTS & CLUB SESSIONS ORGANISED BY STC TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER ALL OTHER PLAY. THESE EVENTS ARE ENTERED ON THE COURT BOOKING SYSTEM.

#### 1. MEMBERS OF SNITTERFIELD TENNIS CLUB:

- Are able to book courts via the web site between the hours of 09:00 and 22:00 seven days a week. If you do not have access to the internet please contact a member of the committee;
- Can turn up and play on the courts at anytime (as above) except when the courts have already been booked;
- Will cover the cost of floodlights themselves;
- Will benefit from the club covering floodlight costs during club sessions and tournaments;
- May play during club open sessions which take place on Wednesday evenings 18:00 - 19:15, 19:30 - 21:00, Fridays 09:30 - 11.30am and Sundays 14:00 - 16:00. These sessions are open to all adult members and invited junior members only;
- May introduce guests to the club at a charge of £5 per hour. The member must be present with their guest. Each guest may visit a maximum 6 times in any year. Please pay either a committee member, Ralf Neilsen or at the bar
- Your annual fee includes social membership to the sports club which includes the Snipe Bar. Please support your facility
- Free parking on site

#### 2. NON-MEMBERS OF SNITTERFIELD TENNIS CLUB

- Are welcome to use court 3 which can be booked via any member of the committee. This can be booked by non-members up to 7 days in advance;
- A fee of £5 per person, per hour is payable. When needed floodlight tokens are to be bought aswell. These are £5 per token with each token affording approximately one hours play. Tokens can be purchased from the Sports Club bar.

## **COURT RULES**

## A LOT OF VOLUNTEER TIME, MONEY AND EFFORT IS PUT INTO KEEPING OUR COURTS TO THE STANDARD THAT THEY ARE, THEREFORE, FOR ALL TO ENJOY, ALL WE ASK IS THAT THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE ADHERED TO...SO PLEASE:

- 1. Don't overtighten the net.
- 2. Do slacken off the net after use.
- 3. Wear appropriate, non-marking, footwear please check for muddy feet. There are shoe brushes at the entrance to each court so no excuses!
- 4. Remember to remove any items you take onto the court, to include balls, empty ball tins, drinks, hats, etc. There are bins located at the front of the club for rubbish and the yellow bin for recycling old balls is outside court 1.
- 5. Don't take glass onto the courts.
- 6. Don't drop chewing gum.
- 7. Do sweep the courts with the brooms provided after use this helps keep the sand distributed and the moss at bay!
- 8. Please adhere to our Code of Conduct which can be found on our website and on the notice board as a reminder!
- 9. Enjoy your tennis!!!

Please note - you enter the court and play at your own risk

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IN THE EVENT OF AN ACCIDENT OR EMERGENCY There is a basic First Aid kit located in the flood light box There is a defibrillator located on the wall at the entrance to the Sports Club

For all 'finished with' balls, please empty them into the yellow bin outside Court 1 - this bin is emptied a couple of times a year for recycling and raises money for the club.

There are bins at the front of the club for disposing of all rubbish.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

# All members of staff and volunteers must agree to:

- Prioritise the well-being of all children and adults at risk at all times
- Treat all children and adults at risk fairly and with respect
- Be a positive role model. Act with integrity, even when no one is looking
- Help to create a safe and inclusive
  environment both on and off court
- Not allow any rough or dangerous behaviour, bullying or the use of bad or inappropriate language
- Report all allegations of abuse or poor practice to the club Welfare Officer
- Not use any sanctions that humiliate or harm a child or adult at risk
- Value and celebrate diversity and make all reasonable efforts to meet individual needs
- Keep clear boundaries between professional and personal life, including on social media
- Have the relevant consent from parents/ carers, children and adults before taking or using photos and videos
- Refrain from making physical contact with children or adults unless it is necessary as part of an emergency or congratulatory (e.g. handshake / high five)
- Refrain from smoking and consuming alcohol during club activities or coaching sessions
- Ensure roles and responsibilities are clearly outlined and everyone has the required information and training
- Avoid being alone with a child or adult at risk unless there are exceptional circumstances
- Refrain from transporting children or adults at risk, unless this is required as part of a club activity (e.g. away match) and there is another adult in the vehicle
- Not abuse, neglect, harm or discriminate against anyone; or act in a way that may be interpreted as such
- Not have a relationship with anyone under 18 for whom they are coaching or responsible
- Not to have a relationship with anyone over 18 whilst continuing to coach or be responsible for them

### All children must agree to:

- Be friendly, supportive and welcoming to other children and adults
- Play fairly and honestly
- Respect club staff, volunteers and Officials
  and accept their decisions
- Behave, respect and listen to your coach
  Take care of your equipment and club property
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, culture, religion or sexual identity
- Not use bad, inappropriate or racist language, including on social media
- Not bully, intimidate or harass anyone, including on social media
- Not smoke, drink alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions or events
- Talk to the club Welfare Officer about any concerns or worries they have about themselves or others

## All adults must agree to:

- Be positive and encourage your child and show an interest in their tennis
- Use appropriate language at all times
- Be realistic and supportive
- Never ridicule or admonish a child for making a mistake or losing a match Treat all children, adults, volunteers,
- coaches, officials and members of staff with respect
- Behave responsibly at the venue; do not embarrass your child
- Accept the official's decisions and do not go on court or interfere with matches
- Encourage your child to play by the rules, and teach them that they can only do their best
- Deliver and collect your child punctually from the venue
- Ensure your child has appropriate clothing for the weather conditions
- Ensure that your child understands their Code of Conduct
- Adhere to your venue's safeguarding policy, diversity and inclusion policy, rules and regulations
- Provide emergency contact details and any relevant information about your child including medical history
