

# **Club Captain Role Description**

### Overview of the Role

This is a volunteer role fulfilled by any adult member who is interested in club competitions and is an experienced league match player. Club Captains are elected at the AGM for a period of one year.

The Club Captain is responsible for organising our annual club tournament schedule and mentoring the Summer & Winter League Captains.

#### What the role involves

### Responsibilities include:

- Developing an annual plan of competitions catering for different ages and standards
- Liaising with committee members to promote events through all possible channels
- Organising volunteers and managing court bookings, entries, entry fees and correspondence for Club competitions
- Determining the competitive team structure in consultation with the members and registering the teams with the respective league secretaries
- Organising, mentoring and supporting league captains
- Ensuring the league captains: organise match practice sessions, collect match fees, balls, courts, player awards and end-of-season team celebrations, plus provide reports for the AGM/Club Annual Dinner where applicable
- Supporting any junior competitions
- Arranging friendly competitions with other clubs
- Promoting Fair Play both on and off court
- Ensuring the club's Safeguarding policy, guidance on ratios, supervision and all other relevant guidance and procedures related to children are adhered to
- Representing the Club at league meetings and events

## Training and support available

No specific training is required for the role. Support will be provided by the elected Officers and other Committee Members.

# Skills and experiences needed for the role

- Interest in competitive tennis
- Approachable and friendly
- Good communication skills
- Good IT and organisation skills
- Reliable and trustworthy

## Commitments

- Attend the various committee meetings, which are typically held from 7-9pm on Thursday evenings every other month, plus the AGM in May.
- Attend the Y&DTL AGM (combined Winter & Summer League event).
- Up to one hour every two weeks and some Saturdays/Sundays for Club tournaments.





• Other commitments include volunteering to help with tasks and at events on a case-by-case basis.
