Useful Membership Information

- Inner and Outer doors to the club. The door can be accessed using the code C3015X. This code will be changed periodically. Updated codes will be notified. Please close the two doors to the locked position if you are last to leave. If coaches are present the door is often left unlocked.

It is important that the door is left locked and ALL lights are off. If you are the last to leave, please check.

- The floodlight key is kept on a hook in the kitchen. This opens the floodlight box outside. Please return it after use.
- Lights will only operate between 7am & 10 pm (condition of our lease). Please remember to switch off the lights as you leave a court if no one is playing after you.
- Please remember to sweep and line clear the courts after use, even if someone is playing after you.
- The mini courts are locked with a coded lock. The code is the same one as the clubhouse. Please note that child members can only play on the mini courts if supervised. (Safeguarding). There will be a key lock into court 3.
- Please access Courts 3, and 4 via the mini courts when possible. It is a matter of politeness and tennis etiquette not to walk through games (particularly when matches are being played). If playing on court 4 please wait until a point has ended before opening either gate into court 3.
- All court bookings are now made online.
- The suggestion and maintenance books are kept on the counter in the club house. Please date and sign any entries. We welcome your feedback.
- The balls in the storage box are for members use. This box is padlocked with the same number as the door code.
- Alphabetical pigeon holes for letters and communication are in the clubhouse
- Use the kitchen safely: please wash up, put away and pay for any refreshments used.
- A first aid box is available in the clubhouse. Please use the booklet to record any minor injuries and fill out an Incident/accident form for anything major.
- We run a number of ladies' men's, mixed and junior teams and competitions. Ask the coaches or any committee member for further information.
- We operate a continuous programme of maintenance and improvement to facilities whilst keeping subscriptions as affordable as possible.

Notes to the Membership Application Form 2020/2021 Season

1. Membership becomes due by March 31st. Payment **MUST** be made in advance to retain/secure your membership rights *especially entry into the Wimbledon Ballot.* **Please make sure your application form is fully completed as we need to check the data is correct.**
2. Any member aware of an existing member not wishing to re-join please encourage them to return their key and fob as soon as possible.
3. Please PRINT on the form and ensure e-mail addresses are very clear. We use them for our regular newsletters, communicating with members and on-line court booking.
4. Columns 5, and 6
 - (A) The LTA *request* details of ethnic background
 - (B) British Tennis Membership and Wimbledon BallotIn addition to other benefits both to members and to the club, if you wish to enter the Wimbledon ticket ballot, you must have a BTM number and have opted into the Wimbledon Ballot. You must have joined or renewed membership of our club by 31st March to qualify. A separate form will be sent with ballot entry details once we know our ticket allocation.
5. The club is limited to 240 playing members. Application is therefore recommended prior to 1st April. Please note that you are not eligible to play after 1st April unless you have re-joined.
6. Any members leaving the club must claim their deposits (key/fob) within 6 months of leaving.
