SUBSCRIPTIONS FOR 2024/25

- Annual Adult members fees have been frozen.
- Junior Membership fees have been reduced by approx. 25%.
- Introduction of a six-month direct debit option for those wishing to spread payments. Please note: The cost will include a small premium to cover administration costs.
- Introduction of an Early Bird Discount. Subscriptions are due on 1st April. However, we are offering a discount in the adult categories **ONLY** to those who would like to pay their subs early i.e., from 1st- 31st March. There will be no early bird discounts in the junior categories as they are already receiving a substantial reduction as with some of the other categories where they are paying low fees anyway.
- **You will receive an invitation via email to renew your membership from 1st March to get the early bird discount. Please DO NOT try to renew before this date.**
