100 CLUB

The 100 Club is run as a private lottery within the Club and anyone over the age of 16 years is permitted to take part in the monthly draws. Friends and family members are also eligible to join. The greater the membership, the more money is raised for the Club and given in prize money. The annual cost is £25 per number which can be paid by standing order, BACS, cheque, or cash. Each participant is given a permanent number in the monthly draw. This number will be retained provided the subscription is maintained. If there are 100 members paying £25 pa raising £2500.00 then £1250 goes to the Club and £1250 goes in prize money. For all months apart from December there are two prizes, one of £50 and one of £25. In December there is a bumper draw with 3 prizes one of £200, one of £100, and one of £75. The scheme runs from March 2024-February 2025. The first draw of the new year will take place at the end of March.
