The French servicemen based at Elvington, joined in and used the courts prior to demobbing which we presume led to the area falling into disrepair.

As a parting gift they donated a trophy to the club, that was presented in the mid 1940s to the tournament winner Anne Beal, and in 2007 was returned for the club. We still compete for this "Free French Cup" today!
