- Monitoring, measuring, auditing and reporting on our health and safety performance;
- Working closely with appropriate external agencies, and within our industry, to ensure our continued adoption of best-practice solutions in health and safety management;

As and when appropriate, we will publish and maintain a series of supporting policies and procedures detailing our Organisation and Arrangements for health and safety, and setting out our approved safe systems of work. These supporting policies and procedures represent an integral part of our Health and Safety Policy.
