The coaching team are aware of their safeguarding responsibilities and have signed up to either the club or LTA Coaches Code of Conduct.

We also have a team of level 1 coaches assisting the camps along with Tennis Leaders who are all fantastic role models to the children attending.

<u>Supervision/Safety</u>

All event participants will be signed in by a member of the coaching team on arrival. Parents have the option of staying to watch or to drop off and return at the end of the half or full day camp.

Each day a lead coach will take all players through the expectations for the day including:

- Where the players are allowed to stay during breaks, including areas of the club that are out of bounds.

- That the aim for the camp is to have as much fun as possible whilst improving their tennis and sporting skills.

All personal property remains the responsibility of the participant and should not be left unattended. The children will remain in the top part of the club and will not be allowed by the front gate entrance.

Our coaching team have a duty of care to all event participants and will act in line with Club/LTA policy to report any safeguarding concerns.

Participants and spectators are also reminded to be familiar with reporting policies should they have any concerns.
