

Twyning Lawn Tennis (TLTC) Club Rules

1. The affairs of Twyning Lawn Tennis Club (TLTC) are managed by an elected committee. The committee will make decisions in line with club procedures and act in the best interest of the club at all times.
2. Subscriptions are due annually on the 1st April and must be paid by March.
3. Clothing and footwear must be appropriate for playing tennis. Coloured tennis/sportswear is allowed.
4. The use of tennis courts is bookable through the online booking system Clubspark only and, pre-booking must be made by members before play takes place. Courts for social play and coaching will be managed by the committee and the club coach through Clubspark for pre-booking by members.
5. Tennis courts are available to book from 9:00 to 21:30 Mon-Fri, Saturdays 9:00 – 21:30 and Sunday 10:00 – 20:00. Note: courts may be booked out for coaching at certain times of the day.
6. A key safe holds keys for access to all the tennis courts and clubhouse. Members will be notified of the relevant code numbers and gate numbers and of any changes. These codes must not be passed on to any non-members in any circumstances. Some members may also be key-holders and the same rules apply.
7. Members must ensure the clubhouse is locked prior to leaving the site after play and, the gate is locked if leaving the site after 20:00, or after a home tennis match.
8. Drinks in non-breakable bottles can be brought onto court and, suitable snacks are allowed. No alcohol is to be consumed during club activities or coaching sessions.
9. Swearing, bad behaviour, discriminatory language or any form of bullying is not acceptable and TLTC, whether on court, within the grounds or in the clubhouse. Any member whether senior, or junior (or visitors) will receive a warning from the committee in line with our club policies. This may lead to a person's membership being terminated.
10. All members of TLTC agree to help create a safe and inclusive environment, both on and off the court. All children and adults at risk are to be treated fairly and with respect, regardless of age, gender, ability, race, culture, religion or sexual identity. Any concerns or allegations of abuse or poor practice are to be reported to the Club Welfare Officer (Hannah Reynolds twyningwelfare@outlook.com or 07804485119) or any member of the Committee initially.
