UBYSC CLUB RULES/GUIDELINES APRIL 2021

The following rules and guidelines are in place to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all.

- All court users must wear suitable footwear (tennis shoes or appropriate trainers) to avoid damaging the court surface and themselves.
- The courts are there to play tennis, No other activities must take place on the courts (e.g. no footballs, bicycles).
- After you have played tennis please remember to loosen the nets, remove anything you have taken on to the courts, lock the courts and both pavilion doors.
- Court and toilet keys are currently issued to adults and juniors on joining. Main Pavilion keys are only issued to Senior/Student members on request at a cost of £20. Unaccompanied juniors are not allowed into the main part of the pavilion.
- Please leave the pavilion clean and tidy, return chairs inside and ensure that the heating and lighting
 are turned off.
- Water drains into a septic tank, so please run as little water down the drains as possible.
- The water in the toilet area sink is not drinking water, so juniors should bring a drinks supply with them.
- Children under the age of 14 should not be left at the Club on their own (i.e. without parent/responsible adult) unless attending organised Junior sessions. Parents must take full responsibility for the conduct and safety of their children at all times.
- The Club welcomes guests of members. A fee of £5 per adult visit (£1.50 per junior) is payable for each visit. Members should ensure they sign the visitors' sheets on either of the notice boards before playing. Members should pay by bank transfer with the details available on the club notice board. Visitors can play 3 times in any one year. Upon joining, any guest fees paid for the current year will be deducted from the cost of membership.
- Members are responsible for their own safety and that of others.
- Any accidents resulting in injury must be recorded in the Accident Book located in the Pavilion.
- The club will not tolerate unacceptable behaviour of any sort towards members, their guests or any others using the courts, e.g.
 - Aggressive or abusive behaviour
 - $\circ \quad \text{Intimidation, including the threat of physical violence} \\$
 - Verbal abuse, harassment or bad language
 - o Substance abuse
 - Behaviour likely to be detrimental to health, safety or welfare
 - Behaviour that causes or is likely to cause damage to the premises or grounds
 - Behaviour that is likely to bring the club into disrepute
- Dogs brought to the club while members are playing must be on a lead or tethered at all times and are not allowed into the pavilion or onto the courts. Members must check and clear up after their dogs before leaving.
